Q1 Do you feel as a result of recent events that UK politicians are less trustworthy?

Much less trustworthy	36.4%
Less trustworthy	38.6%

Q2 Should MPs be reimbursed for the cost of working in two places?

No, salary is sufficient **10.6%** No, but increase salary to cover **16.8%** Yes, for properly incurred costs **71.1%**

Q3 Do you believe MPs should be able to have paid outside interests?
