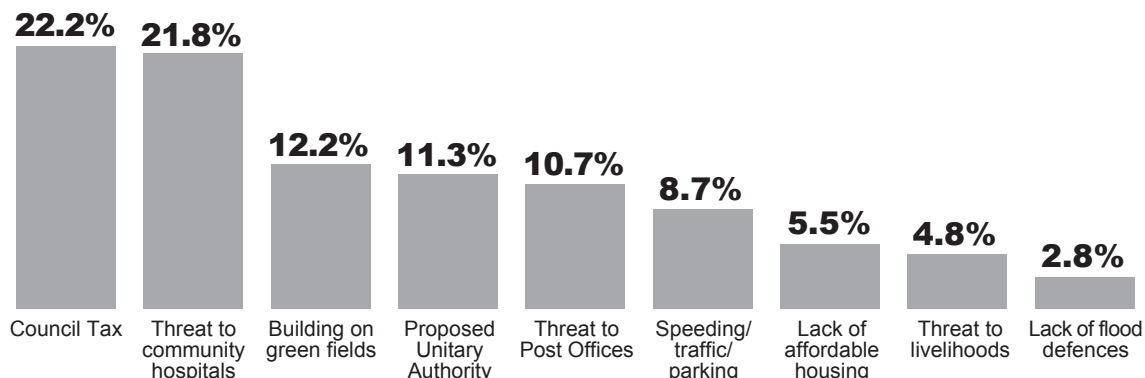


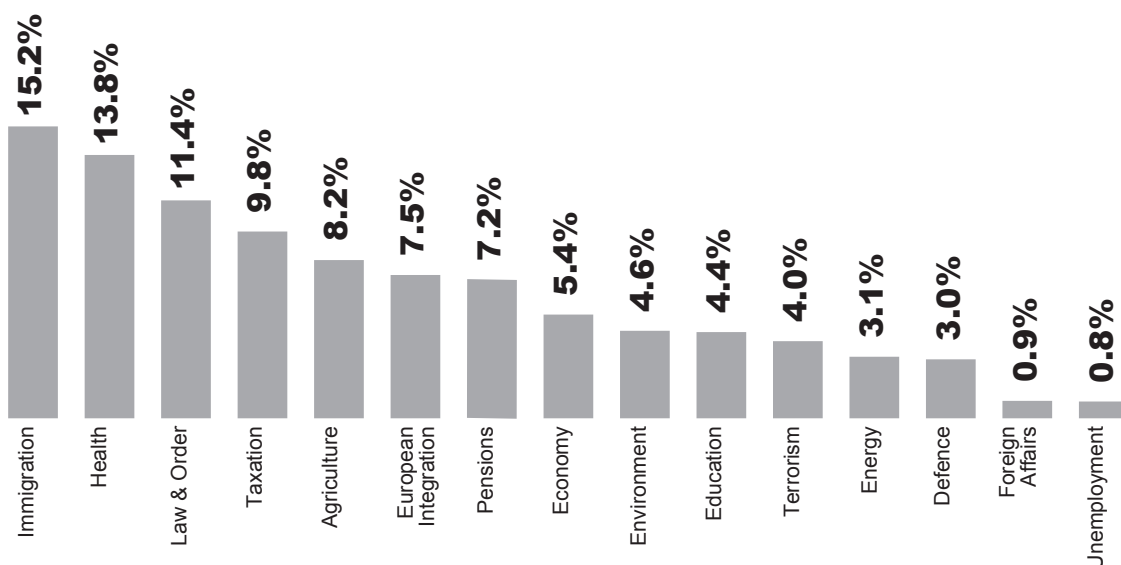

■ **Which NATIONAL ISSUES are of greatest concern to you?**

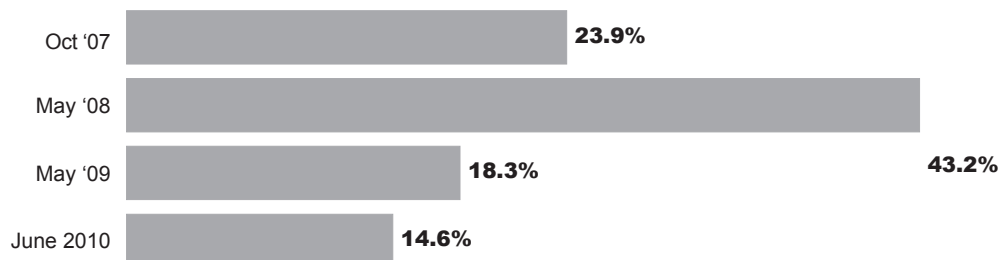
